SECTION A

TouchMoney Inc. The commercially available accounting software has numerous extra features that they may not really use, but it would enable them to do more than just basic accounting.

So they informally approach Stevie Gerr to advise them on the matters. Stevie Gerr runs a very successful branding company, with offices in the fancy upper part of the CBD. He has been involved in corporate branding issues for more than 15 years. After listening to TouchMoney executives explain their predicament Stevie makes the following suggestions.

"I would first recommend that you focus on the hardware devices that you need to put in place. We can provide these for you. Now, given that you also run a training centre you can benefit greatly from a number of new technologies such as getting modern-day digitalized scanners that use a stylus so you can mark your students' multiple choice answers. Hardware must be compartible so you don't have any problems. So you can buy either tape storage devices or magnetic disks since they are basically the same thing as they work the same way and are made of magnetic media. Alternatively you can also get optical storage devices especially CD-ROM as they provide the benefit of allowing end-users to save their work every time they work or update their reports. Then finally get a printer. Don't buy a dot matrix printer as it prints the dots that appear on the monitor. The dots are called pixies by the way. That is my initial assessment of your situation."
