- iii) Label **five (5)** pattern markings on sketches of **two (2)** main pattern pieces from ii) above. (10 Marks)
- b) Outline the construction sequence followed to sew and complete the child's garment from the patterns generated in a) above. (10 Marks)

## **QUESTION 2**

- a) Name and differentiate the two (2) types of facings that can be used to finish a hemline. (8 Marks)
- b) Using diagrams outline three (3) steps for stitching and finishing a plain ruffle and three (3) steps for joining the ruffle to a seam. (12 Marks)
- c) Discuss five (5) major differences between the informal method of pattern making used in Apparel Construction III (TAD305) and the formal Apparel Pattern Design in TAD203.

- a) Use sketches to illustrate **three (3)** ways in which the bias ruching may be used to decorate apparel. **(6 Marks)**

- c) Give six (6) points on how test garments helped you improve the patterns and subsequently the fit of the final garment. (12 Marks)
