- (a) Differentiate what happens when you modify off set even and when you create off set even. (10 Marks)
- (b) How do you shape the Peter pan collar on the front section? (4 Marks)
- (c) In making a Peter Pan collar, which piece is the target piece and which one is the set piece? (4 Marks)
- (d) When joining two pieces/patterns together, should you be on cursor or value mode? (2 Marks)
- (e) When making pleats using the software, describe how you make a box pleat using the system? (10 Marks)
- (f) Indicate what F1 to F10 function keys stand for? (10 Marks)

QUESTION 2

- (a) Create a storage area with your identity number. (2 Marks)
- (b) Select a sleeve pattern block from Data90 and create a puffed sleeve to the elbow level. (15 Marks)
- (c) Add a hem of 3.0 cm and save the new piece. (3 + 2 = 5 Marks)
- (d) Mark a line 5cm below the elbow. (3 Marks)
- (e) Separate the sleeve cap from the lower portion of the sleeve and add a seam allowance of 1.5 cm along the split line, and save piece. (5 Marks)

- (a) Create a storage area with your identity number, if not created before. (2 Marks)
- (b) Select a front bodice block from Data90, create an extended front facing, add seam allowances, and save it. (14 Marks)

- (d) Select the back piece and create a full back neck facing, add seam allowances and save it. (10 Marks)
