SECTION A

- 1. Human beings cannot but communicate, especially, talk or speak, in the multifarious situations they find themselves; but Deutschmann identifies distinct situations in which humans communicate, to wit, communication situations. (25 marks)
 - i. **List** the "communication situations" identified by Deutschmann, and then **describe** each of them, with particular regard to the *natural* and/or *artificial* (man-made) means involved in speech communication. (15)
 - ii. It may be argued that conversation is the most common or frequent type of speech communication. **Indicate** the communication situations in which conversation can take place, and **examine** the nature of conversation. (10)
- 2. Language is the principal vehicle of speech communication. **Describe** the main divisions of language and **state** how their knowledge can improve our performance. (25 marks)
- 3. Explain TWO of the following: (a) i nterview, (b) discussion, and (c) debate; then, discuss the value of each for individuals, groups, organisations, and/or society.
