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### **QUESTION 1(COMPULSORY): (40 MARKS)**

#### **SCENARIO**

Maria Shongwe, a Swazi female aged 32 years is currently working as a human resource officer with Ngwane Mills, an organisation she joined four months ago. She previously worked for Mhlume Sugar company for five years and six months. Most of her experience has been in the human resource development field. She is experiencing a lot of anxiety since she started this job, because what the job actually entails is not what she thought it would be. The job is very administrative and not very challenging for her. Secondly, she has received a job offer from another company, which she feels will be more challenging. She is undecided whether to leave the current company and take this new position. She feels very guilty about wanting to leave her current position because it is very flexible and the environment is very relaxed. This dilemma is causing her a lot of anxiety. She feels that she is not gaining enough experience in new areas. Lastly, she is currently completing a Master's degree in Industrial Psychology, which is an intensive course. She is struggling to cope with the workload and at the same time working and finding a balance with work and life. This too is causing an amount of stress.

- (i) How would you describe Shongwe's career development challenges?
- (ii) What are Shongwe's major career concerns?
- (iii) Why is she experiencing career indecision?
- (iv) Prepare an outline of the process you would follow to facilitate Shongwe's career decision-making ability. [20 marks]
