QUESTION 1 (This question is compulsory and must be answered by all candidates)

Write a position paper in which you justify the inclusion of siSwati as a compulsory subject for all Swazi nationals at the secondary school level. {25 Marks}

QUESTION 2

- (a) Describe the linguistic setting of Swaziland and suggest the direction a language policy might take given this linguistic setting, especially considering what has happened in other Commonwealth SADC countries. What would be the implication of this on the school curriculum? {10 Marks}
- (b) Societies have been forced to relinquish their mother tongue because of issues of religion, colonialism and lingua franca. Explain how each one of these have affected Swaziland. {15 Marks}

QUESTION 3

Discuss the use of behavioral instructional aims and objectives pointing out their premise, advantages and limitations. {25 Marks}

QUESTION 4

The lecture method remains one of the most prevalently used methods in the siSwati classroom and yet it has been greatly criticized.

- (i) Discuss five of the criticisms that have been levelled against this method of teaching
- (ii) Suggest ways in which the negative effects of using this method may be reduced. {10 Marks}

QUESTION 5

Write short notes on the following methods of teaching and state how you would use them in the teaching of siSwati:

- (a) Dramatization
- (b) Independent Study/ the project method {25 Marks}

QUESTION 6

- (a) Identify and discuss three advantages of using discussion as a method (any type of discussion) in mother tongue instruction. {15 Marks}
- (b) Discuss the values that a teacher must try and inculcate through the use of the discussion method. {10 Marks}
