- (a) Identify and discuss four reasons why pupils may feel inhibited from participating in a siSwati class discussion. [20 Marks]
- (b) What might a teacher do to ensure that all pupils participate?

Question 3

There is a debate that has gone on for the past two decades among educators on whether or not Swazi students(at secondary school level) should be allowed to choose between siSwati and French or whether siSwati, as the mother tongue, should be one of the compulsory subjects on the curriculum at this level. As a siSwati teacher identify and discuss five reasons why siSwati should be compulsory (at least for Swazi nationals) at this level of schooling.

- (b) Discuss and illustrate Mager's three criteria for writing behavioural instructional objectives. [15 Marks]

(a) Role Play [10 Marks]
