 - iii. Status planning vs corpus planning
 - iv. Mother toungue vs national language (20 Marks)

- (a) Identify and discuss three advantages of using discussion as a method (any type of discussion) in mother tongue instruction. (15 Marks)
- (b) Discuss the values that a teacher must try and inculcate through the use of the discussion method. (10 Marks)

Question 3

- (a) Identify and discuss three general principles a teacher must observe in order to make effective use of dramatization as a method of teaching (6 Marks)
- (b) Identify and discuss five advantages of using dramatization in a siSwati class. (15 Marks)

(c) Discuss two limitations of using dramatization.

Question 4

Write a position paper in which you justify the inclusion of siSwati as a compulsory subject for all Swazi nationals at the secondary school level. (25 Marks)

- (a) Write short notes on the following methods of teaching methods pointing out both their advantages and limitations. Discuss how you would use these methods in mother tongue instruction:
 - (i) Panel discussion
 - (ii) Role play
 - (iii) Class discussion
 - (iv) Project/research method
