QUESTION 1

- (a) Briefly explain what is meant by the term the “birds-eye-view” of an object. (5 marks)
- (b) Why do pupil in the pre-operational stage of development often fail to understand that a map represents reality? (5 marks)
- (c) Suggest a strategy that could be used to help pupils draw a map of their classroom. (10 marks)
- (d) Describe three Piagetian tasks that could be administered to estimate pupils’ ability to conceptualise spaces. Draw appropriate diagrams to illustrate your answer. (30 marks)

- (a) It is often claimed that dividing a class into small groups enhances learning. How valid is this claim? Provide evidence to support your opinion. (10 marks)
- (b) Discuss one advantage and one criticism of four criteria that are used for grouping students. (40 marks)

- (b) Discuss two strategies that are often used to combat verbalism in conceptual learning. (10 marks)
