Using Hertzler's functions of the mother tongue, write a position paper to the director of education in which you argue why siSwati should be a compulsory rather than an optional subject in the Swazi school system. - (b) Using relevant examples differentiate between the following concepts which are used in language planning, policy and implementation: [15Marks]

 - (iii) Status planning vs corpus planning
