- b. According to McNeil (1985) Needs Assessment is a process by which educational needs are defined and priorities made.
 - You have been appointed as the chairperson of the committee to carry out the needs assessment exercise in your teaching subject, discuss in detail how your committee would carry out the task. (15marks)

- a, Explain in detail how the Oliva's model and the wheeler's model are improvements on the Tyler's model. (15marks)
- b. i. Explain the term Cultural Analysis. (2marks).
 - ii. Show how the two actions involved in cultural analysis have been applied in a **named** curriculum development in Swaziland. (8marks)

Answer any two questions from Questions 3 to 5 below.

Brunner, Smith & Burnett(1985) listed the sources of objectives in curriculum development as:

- i. demands of the culture
- ii. application of knowledge

- iv. General education

- a. Explain the term 'Education for Sustainable Development' (ESD). (5marks).
- b. Discuss the relationship between ESD, culture and curriculum development. (12marks)
- c. Use specific examples to show how ESD has been infused into a named subject curriculum. (8marks)

QUESTION 5

- a. There are two related aspects in curriculum evaluation. Clarify the nature and purpose of each facet as well as their interrelations. (10marks)
- b. Suppose you have been appointed into a newly established curriculum evaluation team for Swaziland secondary education as a representative of your teacher association. Discuss in detail the work you expect your team to be doing, identifying possible pitfalls and reasonable counter reactions. (15marks)
