Using the novel **Umsamaliya Lolungile** by Betty Sibongile Dlamini, discuss **three** major effects of reading fiction. [25 Marks]

Question 5

Choose **one** traditional song you enjoy most

- (a) Write the first **five** lines of this song. [5 Marks]
- (b) Identify and discuss at least **four** moral lessons depicted by the song. [20 Marks]

Question 6

In reading fiction "If we admire or dislike a fictional character it is largely because she/he represents values of which we approve or disapprove. We may even disapprove of a character's action but continue to value her/him" (Schneider, Walker & Childs, 1960).
