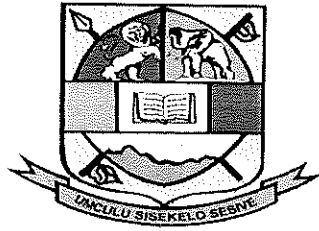

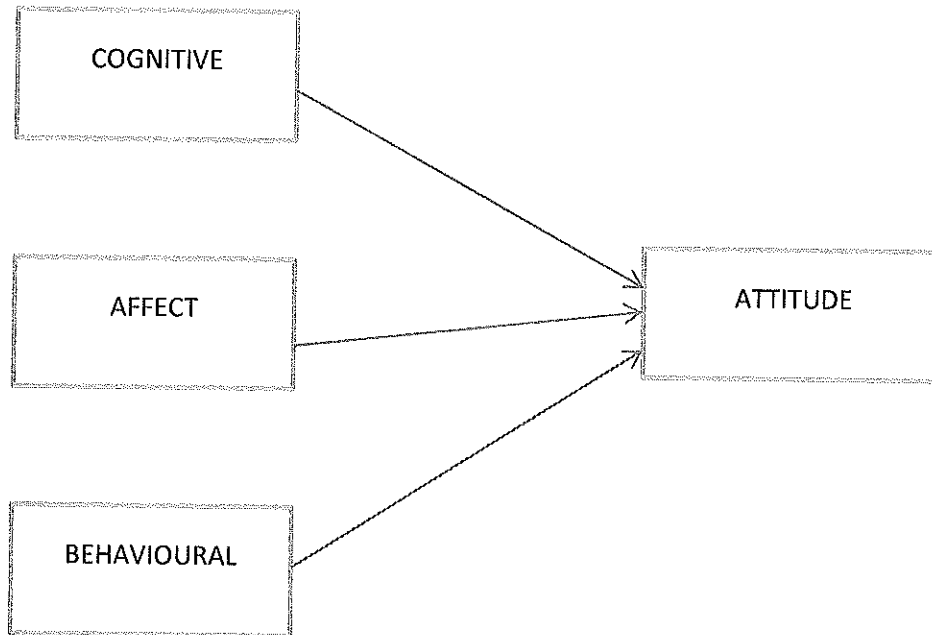


FIGURE 1: The Multicomponent Model of Attitude
