- 4. Bikwaphi declares that she is a witch in her heart, and Nabosikhova concurs by saying it is likewise for every woman. Discuss how these statements sum up the relations among the wives in the polygamous situation presented in <u>A Witch in my Heart</u>. [30]
- 5. In the <u>Merchant of Venice</u>, Shylock, a Jew is presented as an individual whose business ethics are wrong but some of the Christian characters are not completely above reproach in their business dealings either. Discuss this view. [30]
