(5) What do you understand by anti-Semitism? How did this manifest itself in: (i) 19th century Europe with reference to the Dreyfus Affair in France and (ii) in 20th century Europe with reference to Hitler's Germany and the Jewish holocaust during World War 11?

(6) How is nationalism in 19th century Europe different from nationalism in Africa particularly in the post World War II era?

(7) Critically evaluate the role of Otto Von Bismarck in the Unification of Germany.

(8) How do you explain the deteriorating relationship between the state and the church in any two continental European countries in the last quarter of the 19th century?
