- (3) Analyse the causes and consequences of the 1848 Revolution in the Austrian Empire.
- (4) Why and how did Otto von Bismarck struggle to isolate France in the post 1870 era?

SECTION B

- (5) Evaluate the contribution of Giuseppe Mazzini and Giuseppe Garibaldi to the unification of Italy.
- (6) Examine the rise of European imperialism in the late 19th century and its implications for the African continent.
- (7) Explain why and how the relationship between the Catholic Church and the State in France deteriorated in the last quarter of the 19th century.
- (8) What do you understand by Nazism? What factors necessitated the rise of the Nazis to power in Germany in the 1930s?
