Some scholars have argued that colonial administration by the Iberians in Latin America was a 'trial and error affair'. Critically discuss this view using relevant facts from the Spanish administration in Mexico.

Give two causes of the Cuban Revolution of 1959 and then proceed to give a full description of the events that unfolded from the time Fidel Castro took charge of the uprisings up to the Bay of Pigs Invasion during his reign.
