QUESTION 2

Discuss three major events which occurred during the flight of King Sobhuza I and the Ngwane from Shiselweni to Dlomodlomo. In each case show how the Ngwane gained protection from the people they met in these areas.

QUESTION 3

Analyse the methods of invasion and conquest used by King Sobhuza I when he dealt with (a) Magwegwe and the rebels at Shiselweni (b) The Maseko of Mgazi (c) The Magagula of Mnjoli.

QUESTION 4

Describe the succession dispute staged by (a) Malambule (b) Somcuba State one reason which make King Sobhuza I partially responsible for the confusion among the Princes.

QUESTION 5

Why is King Mswati II said to have been the 'greatest fighting Swazi King'? Then explain how he dealt with the various clans which were not conquered by his father in the Lubombo region.
