- 3. Name FIVE types of errors of grammar, give an example of each, and explain how you would correct each error.
- 4. **Discuss** *style* and explain why a *stylebook* is an imperative for any mass/news media organisation.
- 5. **Describe** the phases of the writing process and show how you would get started on a composition.
- 6. **Analyse** grammar in terms of its two fundamental units that every writer must master.
