- 1. One question which overarchs this course is: "Why should journalists especially study economics, of all the social sciences?"
 - (i) Articulate three reasons why journalists should study economics.
 - (ii) **Describe** how an economy may be *framed* to ensure that journalists report, analyse, and comment on it adequately.
 - (iii) **Explain** what reporting, analysing, OR commenting on the economy involves.
- 2. As a reporter about to interview three economists on issues raised by the current National Budget, state a specific subject-matter that underlies the views of economists, which you need to understand about them; then explain this subject-matter and show how it will guide your interview.
- 3. **Demonstrate** that you are conversant with economic reporting in Swazi newspapers by **discussing** how they cover and comment on the basic economic goals and the socio-economic goals of society.
- 4. Whether they know it or not, everyday, journalists cover and comment on public policies, all of which have an economic dimension. **Define** and **explain** "public policy;" then **state** the economic dimension of two named public policies.
- 5. Identify and explain economic systems; then, describe the Swazi economic system.
- 6. Answer A or B.

A: Distinguish economic growth from economic development; then, comment on them with regard to Swaziland.

B: **Examine** the main linkages involved in international trade and **comment on** the issue of AGOA, with regard to Swaziland.
