- 3. **Describe** the video mixer and **explain** its functions in television production.
- 4. **Discuss** the functions of the director and the assistant director.
- 5. Write the script for the first episode of the programme you have proposed in Question 1.
- 6. **Draw** the *lighting* and *floor plan* for a discussion programme you want to produce in a studio.
