Section A: Data Analysis

- 1. Two tools which may be used in conjunction to expose the scope of **quantitative** data analysis are the *Data Refinement Continuum* and the 9-Cell Schema. Explain, with illustrations.
- 2. Answer A or B.

A: **Explain** the *structure of data*; then, **illustrate** it by constructing a codebook of TEN relevant items.

B: Attachment 1 is a data matrix. Use it to **construct** a bivariate (contingency) table for Variable 2 and Variable 3; then, **answer** the following research question.

"Do women with higher education watch fewer soap operas than women with lower education?"

3. The analysis of *qualitative* data differs considerably from the analysis of *quantitative* data. **Explain** the activities and devices involved in qualitative data analysis.

Section B: Report Writing

- 4. In a systematic manner, formulate a research problem that pertains to mass communication; then, write the Methodology chapter for it.
- 5. Answer A or B.

A: Mention and explain the major differences between *qualitative report writing* and *quantitative report writing*.

B. Identify and describe FIVE of the six "alternative forms of writing qualitative research," as espoused by Creswell (2005).

6. Writing can make or mar a research report; hence the qualities of a research report cannot be separated from its writing. **Discuss** EIGHT essential qualities of writing which must be brought to bear on a research report, with particular attention to its various parts.
