UNISWA FOOD OUTLET SELLS STUDENTS POISIONUS FOOD

MATSAPHA – Two Uniswa students survived food poisoning after having bought food from 50's kitchen last Friday.

The students presented with symptoms of food poisoning 30minutes after eating rice and pork from the outlet. It is said that the students were rushed to Mbabane Government Hospital after they started vomiting, having watery diarrhea and fever.

Kwanele Shongwe a third year Social Science students said that he started feeling weak and dizzy and had fever which was followed by diarrhea and vomiting 30 minutes after he ate the rice and pork. He further said, "I bought rice and pork at 50's kitchen and ate it two hours after I bought it and think that is why it had a poisonous effect on me as the doctor said meat can develop some form of bacteria which causes food poisioning sysmtopms when it has been left for a while am unrefrigerated place"

The doctors confirmed the two boys had eaten contaminated food and that is why they presented with signs of C.perfringens which causes clostridia infection, which leads to watery diarrhea, vomiting and fever. They said that this condition usually occurs when one ingests food prepared under unhygienic conditions. It can be found in meat, soil, feces, air and water.

They further said that the condition of the two boys may be a result of eating the meat which was left over a period of time and developed C.perfringens which sometimes survives cooking or they ate food that was prepared by someone who did not wash their hands thoroughly after using the toilet.

When the owner of 50's kitchen was interviewed about the matter he denied that the boys presented with symptoms of food poisoning because of the food they ate from his restaurant. He said, "I am not denying that the boys bought food from my restaurant because I saw them, I know them because they are my regular customers but, I deny the fact that they were affected by the food prepared by may restaurant, because if that was the case all the students who bought food at my restaurant that Friday could have suffered food poisioning symptoms. Maybe they ate polony."

KWALUSENI CHAIRPERSON ATTACKED BY STUDENTS

KWALUSENI- The chairperson of Kwaluseni campus Majobo Phinda Tsabedze was attacked by students on Friday, during fresher's ball.

Celmusa Vilakati who was at the scene before the incident happened said. "The guy (whom I don't know) first called him Judas Iscariot and a coward and then there was a huge fight at the back entrance of the hall. He was later seen carrying a huge knife trying to protect himself from the group of the students."

Students are suspecting Tsabedze for the suspension of the 25 students at UNISWA. He is said to be part of the students who were disturbing classes but he was not suspended together with Vice President Ncaba. Students suspect that Tsabedze provided the administration with the names of those who are suspended because the administration failed to explain the criteria the used to select the students who were disturbing classes.

Tsabedze said he has nothing to do with the suspension of the students he also had it as a rumour on facebook that some students were suspended. "I have been fighting for these students, going to the admin every single day to convince them, but it is very painful that students are thinking that I am a traitor."
