 - (ii) The time spent reading newspapers will vary according to age.
 - (iii) Do journalism students read newspapers more than non-journalisms students?
 - (iv) Knowledge of current affairs will be related to exposure to news in newspapers and on television.
- 4. **Describe** the major parts of a research report, specifying their elements or subparts.
- 5. **Explain** the stages of data analysis for both qualitative and quantitative research.
- 6. **Discuss** the essential differences between a qualitative research report and a quantitative research report.
