Homosexual acts are already illegal in Uganda, and Museveni had gone back and forth recently about whether he would sign the controversial bill in the face of vocal opposition from the West. At the public signing of the bill Monday, a defiant Museveni declared that he would not allow the West to impose its values on Uganda.
