Question 1

Critically assess the place of puberty rituals in contemporary African society. Draw specific examples from at least two different contemporary African societies to illustrate your views.

Question 3

Drawing specific examples from at least two different case studies, explain the meaning(s) of sacred monarchies in contemporary African societies. What, in your opinion, is the proper function of sacred monarchies today?

Question 4

Traditional African Religion reinforces (directly and indirectly) patriarchal and sexist traditions, norms and values that prevail in contemporary African society. What steps need to be taken to promote gender equality in our day and age?
