Question 1

What are your views on the declaration in Deuteronomy 8:22 that "... when a prophet speaks in the name of the LORD, if the word does not come to pass or come true, that is a word which the LORD has not spoken; the prophet has spoken it presumptuously, you need not be afraid of him?" [20]

Question 6

Write a critical commentary on the oracle provided below:

"Hear this word, you cows of Bashan,
