- b) Discuss the major problems facing agricultural development in Swaziland. [15 marks]

- a) What is meant by land tenure? Briefly explain the land tenure arrangements that exist in Swaziland. [9 marks]
- b) Discuss the effects of the Land tenure System on agricultural development in Swaziland. [14 marks]

Question 6

- a) Agriculture on Swazi Nation Land (SNL) is becoming more and more vulnerable to crop failures. What do you think are the possible causes of crop failures on SNL. [15 marks]
- b) Suggest possible solutions that can be applied to address the problem. [10 marks]

Question 7

- a) What are the basic features of household decision making models? [7marks]
- b) Discuss the basic elements of the Chaynov household model. Show how the allocation of time between work and leisure is derived. [18 marks]

Question 8

- a) Give the rationale for government's intervention in the agricultural sector in developing economies? [10 marks]
- b) Discuss the possible policy options that governments in developing countries can pursue to uplift the agricultural sector. [15 marks]
