According to Smit J, in *Black v Barclays Zimbabwe Nominees (Pty) LTD 1990 (1) SACR 433 (W)*, "an individual's statutory power to institute a private prosecution is a "safety valve", so to speak, in the machinery of the law. It is also to some extent an indirect method of controlling corruption or incompetence in the State's prosecutorial services. Do you agree? Discuss the validity or invalidity of this statement, making reference to decided cases.
