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OUESTION 1 (Compulsory)

Draft the 'causa' (recital) in respect of the transactions or set of facts listed below:

- (i) Husband and wife executed a joint will with massing and bequest of property registered in the deceased's name to the surviving spouse subject to a *"fideicommissum"*, but fiduciary dies before registration. [5]
- (ii) Husband and wife executed a joint will with massing and bequest of property to children as heirs, subject to a *"usufruct"* in favour of the surviving wife, but who repudiates and claims half share.
- (iii) Husband and wife married in community of property with property registered in the name of deceased husband who died intestate, and two minor children. [5]
- (iv) Sale to a company, not yet incorporated at the date of sale. [5]
- (v) Sale to a person who was married in community of property but who dies before registration of transfer.
