- 5. Examine the subjectivist-objectivist controversy in sociological theorizing. Citing the works of specific scholars, explain how sociologists have attempted to resolve this controversy.
- 6. Identify and discuss the defining features of postmodernism in sociological theory. Cite relevant examples from the literature to support your arguments.
