QUESTION 1

Read the following case study and answer questions that follow:

Fuzile is 17 years old living with his siblings who are 14 and 11 years old, sharing a one small hut. Their parents both died of AIDS related illnesses. Their extended family members are not known to the community. They lack basic needs like food and shelter. They visit the local care centre where they get one meal a day; unfortunately this care centre sometimes runs short of food supply. Fuzile and his siblings are not at school due to lack of school funds and because the other children laugh at them. Gobhogobho River passes through the land their parents left them.

- a) What strengths do these children have? **(5 marks)**
- b) Briefly discuss **two (2)** factors you think make these children live in adversity. **(10 marks)**
- c) With an aid of examples, explain what intervention strategies you would use to support these children
 - i) physically
 - ii) socially. **(10 marks)**

QUESTION 2

Discuss **five (5)** characteristics that you think have contributed to your being a successful learner while concurrently working with children and youth. Draw examples from your own experiences. **(25 marks)**

- a) Draw a diagram that illustrate Johari's window. **(5 marks)**
- b) Discuss what each of the **four (4)** parts of your Johari's Window mean to you as a person who helps children and youth. **(20 marks)**

QUESTION 4

- a) What does gender awareness mean to you as a development facilitator? **(5 marks)**
- b) Discuss **four (4)** factors that you have identified in your community, which make women more vulnerable to HIV infection.

- a) Discuss the needs of children in each of the following stages of development and also show how you would positively manage their behaviour
