Discuss the Swazi concept of “*tibi tendlu*” (family secrets) focusing on how it has entrenched the perpetual cycle of family violence.

Discuss how a social worker would demonstrate basic skills for detecting family violence and promoting help - seeking for both the abuser and the survivor.
